Course Context/Audience:

An introduction to the "TEACCH" approach for teachers and teaching assistants from primary, secondary and special schools with limited knowledge of Autistic Spectrum Disorders (ASD).

Objectives:

TEACCH is a structured teaching approach which maximises the visual presentation and minimises verbal instruction. The structure is aimed at making the best use of the strengths of children with ASD, their visual skills and adherence to routine, therefore using these strengths to help minimise their difficulties. The course covers the principles of using TEACCH in various contexts including promotion of social skills and interaction. This course might be of interest to those who already have a knowledge of TEACCH and wish to extend how they use it.

The course is co-ordinated by Asperger East Anglia.
