

Wells Field Study Centre Late Booking Opportunities 2006 – 07

Wells Field Studies centre is ideally located within the heart of the small historic port of Wells-next-the-sea in north Norfolk, mid way between Cromer and Hunstanton within the North Norfolk Coast Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. It is special for its wildlife, buildings and cultural landscape. The centre is five minutes walk from the quay and close to a variety of habitats such as sandy beaches, salt marsh, sand dune, intertidal mudflats and pinewoods within the Holkham

National Nature Reserve. River, chalk grassland, ancient woodland, historical buildings, a deer park, farms and archaeological sites are all close by and easily accessible by foot or in the centre's 17 seater minibus.



The centre was awarded Eco Centre status in 2002, earning the prestigious Green Flag for our efforts to incorporate sustainability into our teaching, centre management, purchasing, field sites and community relations.
