WORKFORCE REMODELLING REVIEW OF TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT SCHOOL SUPPORT STAFF

Norfolk's Workforce Remodelling Team commissioned NAPTA to undertake a pilot skills audit for school support staff in 2005. Due to the success of this pilot and in answer to school requests, we are happy to extend this service and invite your school to take part in the extension of this programme, which is **FREE**.

The skills audit will enable schools to:

- Identify existing skills and knowledge;
- Increase the contribution staff make to helping pupils and colleagues;
- Plan professional development for support staff;
- Complete Ofsted self-evaluation forms using data from the exercise.

Schools will be provided with:

- Necessary training to relevant staff;
- Profiling exercise 1 hour session for participant;
- Web-based collection and analysis of data:
- Feedback sessions including;
 - a whole-school Report and Review for each support staff member;
 - Guidance on the interpretation and use of the information at both individual and institutional level.

At this stage we need to establish how many schools wish to take part and would ask you to complete the attached form, registering your interest, and return by Friday, 7th July, 2006 at the latest.

The process will begin early in the Autumn Term with briefings for Headteachers around the County in the weeks beginning 18th September and 25th September; training for staff during the first two weeks of October; and results being fed back to schools by the end of the Autumn Term 2006.

It would also be useful for schools with computer suites to indicate whether they would be willing to share these with colleagues for the completion of an online questionnaire to facilitate the process and keep associated costs down.
