Are you aware of the Co-operative Young Film-makers Festival? Held each October at the award-winning National Museum of Photography, Film and Television, Bradford, it is a festival (NOT a competition) of young people's filmmaking organised by the Co-operative Group.

The Ipswich & Norwich Co-operative Society are working in conjunction with Cinema City in Norwich and Ipswich Film Theatre to support local young film-makers who may be entering the national festival. If you or your group intend to enter please let us know and we may be able to support you. We are also intending to host a pre-screening of films submitted from the region at Cinema City on Tuesday 28th June giving local entries an opportunity to be seen.

There is still time to enter this year's festival. The film-maker/s must be 21 years of age or under – there is no lower age limit. The film must be 6 minutes or under and the closing date for entries is 27th June 2005.
