

Nelson Summer Workshops

The Central School of Dance and the Performing Arts in association with Norwich Playhouse are providing a once in a lifetime opportunity to learn about the life and times of one of Norfolk's greatest sons, Horatio Nelson. Born in Burnham Thorpe in 1758, a captain before he was 21, a household name throughout Europe at 39, and killed in action just three weeks after his 47th birthday, Nelson lived a colourful and crowded life.

We will be running eight two hour long workshops at 10.00 am and 1.00pm from the 12^{th} to the 15^{th} July. Places are limited to 60 per session at £3.00 per child, so book early and don't miss the boat!

The project will include acting, singing and dancing all with relevance to role-playing a re-enactment of life at sea in the 18th century, learning at first hand the various skills and tricks you would need to keep your head above water.

The workshops will provide a platform of ideas and experiences to help schools undertake their own projects on Nelson in the autumn term, when the 200th anniversary of the Battle of Trafalgar will be celebrated. There will be an opportunity to buy a newly-devised script on the life of Nelson with casting and scenes flexible enough to be used in a wide range of schools.

Although the workshops will be self-contained, children will be invited back to a special performance celebrating the life and times of Nelson at the Playhouse on Friday 15th July at 6.00pm. Hopefully they will be able to remember all they've learnt at their workshop, as there will be a very important guest present!
