This years lucky winners could receive up to £100 worth of prizes and an opportunity to attend the National Award Ceremony at Earls Court on 12th October 2005. With the deadline for the competition being 1st September 2005, we are keen to get as many children between the ages 5 and 11 involved in the campaign, and it is our hope that schools, teachers and parents nationally will share our enthusiasm.
