### Practising to Support Parents

We had an excellent turn out for our Independent Parental Supporter course in Mattishall this spring.



Here the group are practising their listening skills and finding out how much they can remember from previous sessions, as they pair up and pretend to be an IPS at a meeting with a parent.

As well as working on their communication skills, the group have also met a variety of professionals and participated in sessions about disability awareness, child protection and voluntary organisations. Obviously we spend lots of time looking at the Code of Practice - School Action, School Action Plus and Statutory Assessment and Statements.

Our volunteer Independent Parental Supporters have helped hundreds of parents over the last 10 years.
