## The work of Macmillan Cancer Relief in Norfolk

During the last six years Macmillan has spent over £4 million in Norfolk to fund local cancer care services.

Our current £1 million appeal will fund a variety of services in our local community including:

- six new Macmillan clinical nurse specialists across the Norfolk & Waveney cancer network
- a palliative care referrals co-ordinator for Central Norfolk
- a Macmillan occupational therapist at the Norfolk & Norwich University Hospital
- two GPs each dedicating a day a week to cancer care
- a lymphedema nurse for North Norfolk

We continue to raise funds for new cancer care services at the Macmillan Care & Treatment Centre in King's Lynn and a Macmillan cancer manager for West Norfolk.

We are hoping that many Norfolk schools will want to host a coffee morning to support our local appeal. The money that your school raises really will make a huge difference to people affected by cancer in Norfolk.
