

The General Medical Council Essay Competition

The General Medical Council essay competition is closing on 13 February 2006.

The essay competition is open to 16 to 18 year olds. Students just have to write a short (800 - 2, 000 word) essay on "What Will the Role of Doctors be in 2050?"

The first prize is £500 and five runner-ups will receive £100 each. The winning essays will be published by the GMC and all essays will help us better understand what students think the future of medicine may look like.
