The Playbarn is the ideal place to visit with a group of young children. We have a great deal to offer both socially and educationally that tie into plans relating to the National Curriculum and Foundation Stage Profile. Our facilities offer a range of activities both indoor and outdoor suitable for children aged 7 and under which include:

- Soft play and indoor climbing equipment
- Ball pool (under 4's)
- Outdoor wooden climbing equipment (over 4's)
- Large indoor sand pits
- Outdoor peddle tractor courtyard

Available all year round with opportunities in every area for children's physical, emotional and social development. Suitable for children with special needs with the correct supervision from accompanying adults.

We can also offer seasonal activities at an extra charge of £1.25 per pupil per activity that have been developed to focus on providing opportunities for informal education. These include our:

- Animal farm (including organised tours and animal petting) excellent for PSHE
- Hand painted maze area (with or without a quiz) touching on basic literacy & numeracy skills
- Nature trail (with the opportunity of mini-beast hunting and pond dipping) brilliant for science/geography with worksheets for you to take back to school to continue the learning.....or just use for wet play!
- Tractor & trailer rides (including 'The Little Red Hen' story and to look at the things around us) links for PSHE and extremely good fun!
- Pony rides - again a fantastic opportunity to get up close to the farm animals with PSHE in mind.

These activities can be made available after the Easter break through until October half term.

I will keep you posted as our educational visits programme develops and we welcome your ideas to make the Playbarn really work for you.

The standard group rate of £3.75 per child (min 12 children) allows access to all areas that are 'in season'. We do not charge for accompanying adults and rely on schools to provide adequate adult support & supervision.  
A pre- group visit is recommended to answer any queries and to share the risk assessment information that we provide.
