

Directions to the Devonshire Place



Devonshire Place is situated within 5 minutes walk of the main line railway station and approximately 7 miles from the junction 21 of the M1/ M69 motorways. The Devonshire Place car park is situated on Prebend street.

From the M69/ Junction 21 of the M1, follow the A563 towards Peterborough, also sign post to Leicester Races. This road continues across two major sets of traffic lights and two roundabouts and joins the A6 at Leicester Race Course.

Turn left onto the Race Course, sign posted to the City Centre and continue down the main **London Road (A6)** towards the City Centre.

At the roundabout with Victoria Park, continue straight on and across 1 pelican crossing and two sets of traffic lights.

Immediately following the second set, Saxby Street (on the corner you will see Islamic Bank of Britain) is on the right hand side. Pass Saxby Street and cross the Pelican lights and 30 yards on the right is Devonshire Place, opposite the Post Office.

Turn immediately right past Devonshire Place into Prebend street and the Devonshire Place Car Park is the second car park entrance on the right.
