Described as 'The Story of Tracy Beaker' meets 'Lord of the Flies', this cheerful and poignant play shows how children deal with being in care when the adults aren't around!

Developed from an original research and development project with young people with experience of the social care system, it is performed by a cast of actors all of whom have had social workers at one time or another in their lives!

Combining performance, original music, live video projection and humour, Lavender's Blue will resonate with all children, and the adults in their lives.

Lavender's Blue is suitable for children aged 7+, their parents or carers and families.
