This one day course is designed to support senior managers who are currently involved in the development of integrated centres. The course will explore the professional and personal demands involved in leading and managing multi-professional, integrated services.

The course follows on from previous courses, which focused on systemic and structural change processes and concentrates on the personal and emotional dimensions of leadership of integrated centres at a time of dynamic change. It will focus on:

- exploring leadership experiences and styles;
- understanding the challenges of multi-professional team leadership;
- developing emotionally intelligent leadership;
- leading a radical change agenda without burnout;
- dealing with leadership dilemmas and paradoxes.

Whilst essentially practice focused, the course will be underpinned by current theory in organisational leadership and management and make clear links to the new National Professional Qualification in Integrated Centre Learnership (NPQICL).

Professors Chris Pascal and Tony Bertram are Directors of the Centre for Research in Early Childhood, which is located in an integrated centre in Birmingham. The Centre is also a designated DFES Regional Leadership Training Centre. They were Directors of the National Evaluation Team for the Early Excellence Centre Programme and much of this course will be based on that research.
