Schools singing for healthy hearts

We are all aware of the increase of childhood obesity; statistics show that over 15% of children in the UK are overweight or obese. Evidence has shown that children who are overweight tend to grow up into adults who are overweight. They therefore have a higher risk of developing serious health problems in later life, including heart attack and stroke, type 2 diabetes, bowel cancer, and high blood pressure.

The pressure is on for schools to help pass on positive 'healthy heart' messages to pupils. National charity Heart Research UK can help, by providing free resources and outsource trained speakers to talk to children about keeping their hearts healthy.

Teachers and parents can order a free 'Sing for your heart' fundraising pack! Sing for Your Heart is an annual fundraising event during the week of 8-15 December, when schools, groups of colleagues, friends and family get together and raise money by organising a singing related occasion.

Many UK schools chose to get involved as they can tie the fundraiser in with Health Education or Music lessons. Schools around the UK have organised carol singing or school concerts to raise money for Heart Research UK and teach the healthy heart message.

Last year Newton Primary School from Dunblane in Scotland helped to raise over £1,000 for Heart Research UK by organising different activities including a sponsored sing-song, which raised over £750 alone. The school chose Heart Research UK, as they had recently learned about heart health in their health education lessons (part of their curriculum). The National Director of Heart Research UK visited the School in person to accept a cheque and give a healthy heart talk.

cure of heart disease. There is a strong emphasis on supporting clinical and surgical projects and young researchers on their first steps into research. The Charity currently funds over £1.8m of research projects at 40 hospitals and universities across the UK. In addition over £100,000 has been awarded to community-based lifestyle projects that aim to prevent or reduce the risks of heart disease.

Exercise is no longer a regular part of everyone's day – some children never walk or cycle to school, or play any kind of sport. And it is not unusual for children to spend hours in front of a television or computer. The National Diet and Nutrition Survey (2000) found that 40-69% of children over the age of six spend less than the recommended minimum of one hour a day doing moderate intensity physical activity.
