This beautiful medieval Cathedral will be the setting to explore core aspects of Benedictine life and worship. An experiential day of learning with costumes, singing, illustrating and ‘hands-on’ workshops in the Herb Garden.

The maximum number each day will be 100 and the cost £4 per pupil.
The event will operate with an introduction, three workshops, lunch and final procession to the High Altar.

Workshops will include:

- **Music and worship based in the choir**
- **Herbs and healing based in the Herb Garden**
- **Illuminated manuscripts based in the Library**

There will also be the chance to see the Luttrell Psalter exhibition showing copies of this fabulous medieval manuscript made on the eve of the Black Death and situating the ordinary folk of the day in the Biblical landscape.
