In the Tudor chambers of the Mansion children unlock the mysteries of Tudor life using actual Tudor objects and portraits, learning how the lives of the rich and poor were very different. Replica costumes (including a 'Bumroll'!) can be tried on by four children. The children become portrait detectives and unlock the secrets of the Tudor portraits.
