A LETTER ABOUT NORFOLK CHURCHES TRUST AND THE ANNUAL BICYCLE RIDE

Dear Headmaster/mistress,

Once again we are writing to you in connection with our annual bicycle ride. This event generates about sixty percent of our annual income. We rely heavily upon the good will of the sponsored riders who visit any number of churches, some redundant, some in use but all open on the day manned by volunteers who check each rider as he or she arrives.

The ride is open to any age and a lot of small children cycle with their parents. All seem to enjoy the ride and the fun of being out in the countryside and meeting lots of people.

This year the ride is on the 14th September and the churches are open all day.

I would ask you please to display the enclosed poster in a prominent place and to encourage your pupils to take part if possible with their parents. They would need to get sponsors to fill in the sponsorship form and to collect the money afterwards. Perhaps you would be prepared to act as coordinator seeing to collection of the monies and the forms.

The alternative is to get the children to contact their local church who would organise the forms and coordinate the money for them.
