An enchanting Tudor leatherworker will show you how leather was crafted to make durable objects. There will be basic belt, purse and bag making and information on tannering leather too.

In the kitchen at the mansion you will be able be to see an important and common skill of Tudor women at work, with demonstrations of fabric and wool dyeing. You can see sources of natural dyes and mordants, as well as a selection of different coloured wools. You'll be surprised at some of the things the Tudors used for dyeing – including urine. But don't worry this example won't be shown on the day!
