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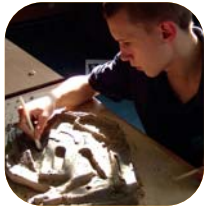

ARTS AWARD



Fruitful Arts is an Art Award registered Center with trained advisors who can support young people to develop as artists and gain a nationally recognized qualification at levels 1, 2 and 3 (Bronze, Silver and Gold).



Arts Award is for all young people aged between 11-25. It recognizes individual development and is assessed by a portfolio of evidence that may be presented in any format and can be undertaken in any art form.



It develops young people's skills as arts leaders and supports them to set goals & improve their own arts practice. Young people are encouraged to look into the wider world of the arts and engage with arts events.

ART EXPRESS THE MOBILE GALLERY



Art Express is a unique Mobile Art Gallery. Each session a Fruitful Arts brings an original piece of contemporary art that has been hired from an emerging or student artist.



Children are encouraged to express their natural curiosity about how and why the artist has made the work. Then they get to explore the process themselves to create something inspired by the artwork but that's definitely an original!



Art Express is a stepping-stone for children who may not have many opportunities to visit Galleries or experience real art 'up close'. It can be delivered in or out of school and has proved to be an extremely effective way to engage hard to reach learners and support them to gain Arts Award accreditation.



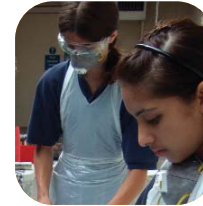
CREATIVE AND MEDIA DIPLOMA
