The programme includes:

- **Face to face development training days** - held in local hotels, focusing on leadership skills
- **Online communities** – for the extension of learning, sharing of ideas and support
- **A School Leadership Project** - allowing the development of new expertise in your school
- **Online learning leadership materials** – web-based resources offering access to information, essential training and development tools
- **The Virtual School** - a computer-simulated school where you can experiment with ideas
- **And much more!**

Applications, which are completed online, open on Monday 1st December 2008 and close at noon on Friday 16th January 2009, for an April 2009 start.

All applications must be from a school-based group of 2-4 members of staff and we regret that individual applications cannot be accepted.

Places, which are heavily subsidised by NCSL, are limited for the next intake. They will be allocated on a strictly first-come, first-served basis so complete your school application early.
