Great Yarmouth Potteries is a family run business that specialises in the design and production of limited edition pottery, paintings and sculpture. We are contacting you to offer your school the opportunity to take advantage of our clay work for Schools classes. We travel to schools across Norfolk and Suffolk providing stimulating workshops in coil and clay work. The emphasis of the classes is to encourage learning whilst offering a fun activity with an end product that the children can take home.

The sessions last approximately 45 minutes, and can be offered as a one off class or a series of workshops geared towards the development of key skills. Workshops can be tailored to meet specific curriculum needs (e.g. Art & Design Unit 1C 'What is sculpture?') or can be linked into current school events. In the past children have made everything from copies of Norwich castle and busts of Tutankhamen to likenesses of David Beckham or even their teachers! Staff require no experience but in the past have enjoyed joining in!

The cost of each session is £40 (a discount is available for multiple bookings) and this includes both the tuition from one of our highly experienced tutors and all the materials and tools required for the class (maximum of 30 children per workshop). An additional charge of 25p per mile is made to cover fuel costs.

In addition to clay workshops we can also offer art classes to schools to cover areas of the Art & Design curriculum including Self Portrait (Unit 1A) and Portraying relationships (Unit 3A).

If you don't want us to come to you then why not come to us! Great Yarmouth Potteries also houses a herring smoking museum and children can learn about how pottery is made, look around the museum and see some of the wonderful paintings on display. Art & Pottery classes can also be delivered at the potteries either for students or as a fun team building activity for teachers!

We have also helped many schools with fundraising activities or commemorative events by producing unique mugs, plates and cups with a school logo or reproduction of a pupils winning design on them.
