Dear Art Teacher,

We were thrilled with our customers' reaction to the first art competitions we ran last year and would like to repeat the event.

We will again be working alongside some of our art material suppliers who have offered to sponsor specific categories of the competition and sit on the judging panel.

As we all know 2002 is the Golden Jubilee Year and we would like to mark the event by theming the competitions accordingly:

“What does the Golden Jubilee mean to you” ?

The competition is open to all schools in the ESPO consortium area. There are four main categories open to pupils in Nursery and Key stages 1, 2 and 3. A further two categories (E & F) are open to all.

A Drawing sponsored by **Staedtler**

B Painting sponsored by **Oasis (Reeves)**

C 3D Modelling/Construction/Sculpture/Collage sponsored by **Edding**

D Printmaking sponsored by **Sanford** who market the **Berol** brand.

E Computer Art sponsored by Hewlett Packard and Robert Horne paper.
This category is open to all schools and colleges but we will take account of age when judging.

There is an additional fourth category for:

F The Best School Display sponsored by **Daler Rowney** which is open to all schools and colleges in the ESPO consortium area. This category is not restricted to the “Jubilee” theme.

- 6 Each entry must have an official entry form (photocopiable master on the back page of this leaflet) completed in ink and fastened securely to the back of each piece of work.

How to enter

- Please fax/post back a completed copy of the 'Expression of Interest' form opposite to register your intention to participate in the competition.
- The Entry Form (back page) can be photocopied as many times as necessary in order to attach a completed entry form to each piece of work submitted.
- ESPO and a panel of judges will evaluate entries during the summer and inform all winners by the end of September 2002.
- If you wish your artwork to be returned, please make this clear on the entry form.
We will endeavour to do this during October 2002.
