Formed by Pendle Productions in 1985 We are a Theatre Company who tours adaptations of classics to all types of venues. The Company, is directed by the founder, Timothy Lince, whose international work has included, three years as a commissioned script and musical Writer/Director for the B.B.C., Artistic Director of Manitou Arts Centre in Toronto and numerous Major Musical and Theatrical tours throughout the U.K.

"From performances in Schools, to Theatres, Arts Centres and Libraries throughout the length and breadth of the Land". 1998 saw two productions being filmed for Central and Border Television and in 1999 we produced a World Premiere adaptation of "James and The Giant Peach". 2000 saw new shows "Alice Through The Looking Glass" and "Tom Sawyer" launched. So successful was the musical of "Alice" that it is back on tour this year by popular request. 2001 saw the arrival of "Martha The Magical Cat", with spectacular costumes, set and reviews to match. "Martha" has proved a 'box office smash' and has turned into a 'theatrical phenomenon'. "Martha The Cat's Magical Christmas" was launched for the winter season. In April 2002 we opened the third Martha show, "Martha the Cat's Great Big Adventure" and this production tours until November. We tour Nationally from the Highlands of Scotland to Jersev, and our name has become synonymous with touring 'quality' performances that will remain in your memory for ever.

Each show is brought to life by two actors using costumes, scenery, props. song and the special ingredient that has become synonymous with our performance style, a sense of fun! Productions last between one and one and a half hours in length (Check at time of booking) and are fully self contained. We require a performance space of no less than 18' by 16', two power sockets, and an audience to entertain.
