Tudor Time Machine

Come and examine the fine Tudor building that is the Green Quay. A visit that explores the stone and brick work of our warehouse and takes your pupils on a journey through time linking in to local history events. Your pupils will soon see how the Green Quay is a re-cycled building and we'll show them how to re-cycle their modern day rubbish as well!

What can we measure?
