

What's on offer for Schools (Art for KS1, 2 & Secondary Students)

**New Art Exhibition at
Norwich Castle Museum & Art Gallery**

**Cedric Morris and Lett Haines
21 October - 5 January**

This vibrant and highly colourful exhibition focuses on Portraits, Still Lives and Flowers. Artists, Cedric Morris and Lett Haines, lived and worked in East Anglia. Their school for painting and drawing attracted many artists, some of whom were to become famous, such as Lucian Freud. This exhibition brings together some of the extraordinarily rich and varied paintings by these artists.

The events below are on offer for primary and secondary schools across the Key Stages. (Cost and booking details overleaf.)

Flower Magic (Event for Reception & KS1)

During this session, a gallery educator will help children to explore some of the large and stunning flower paintings in the exhibition. Then children can have a go at drawing their own flower still life in the gallery, sketching from a 'real-life' vase filled with flowers.

The session lasts 45 mins.




(Cyfartha Castle Museum & Art Gallery)

Looking at Portraits (Event for KS2)

The session, led by a gallery educator, takes children on an exploration of some of the many portraits on view in this new exhibition - including ones by Cedric Morris and Lucian Freud. There is also a worksheet to help groups explore some of the portraits in the Castle's permanent collections.

(Entire session lasts about 90 mins, ie, gallery-led session - 45 mins - and worksheet - a further 45 mins.)

The artists Cedric Morris and Lucian Freud (For Secondary Schools)

This educator-led gallery session begins with a brief background to Cedric Morris and one of his most famous students, Lucian Freud. It then explores some of the artists' paintings on display in the exhibition, looking especially at their portraits and techniques.

The gallery-led session takes 45 mins. Afterwards, students are encouraged to spend time in the gallery sketching. (Please ensure that students bring their sketchbooks.)
