Climate Change Levy

With effect from 1st April 2001 all non-domestic use of energy is subject to Climate Change Levy of 0.43p/kWh. Exemptions are available if you are:

- eligible for the lower rate of VAT (currently 5%) on energy supplies
- a Registered Charity
- using all or some of the energy for non-business purposes, e.g. for residential accommodation






Your Supply Number Explained






