Wednesday June 11th 4.30-6.00pm

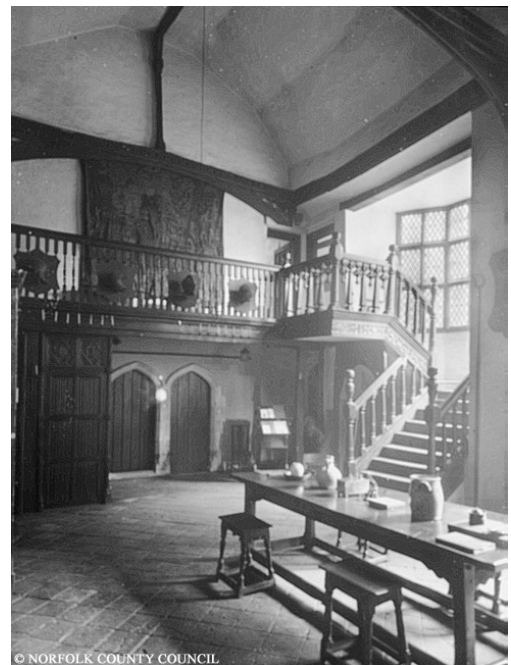
