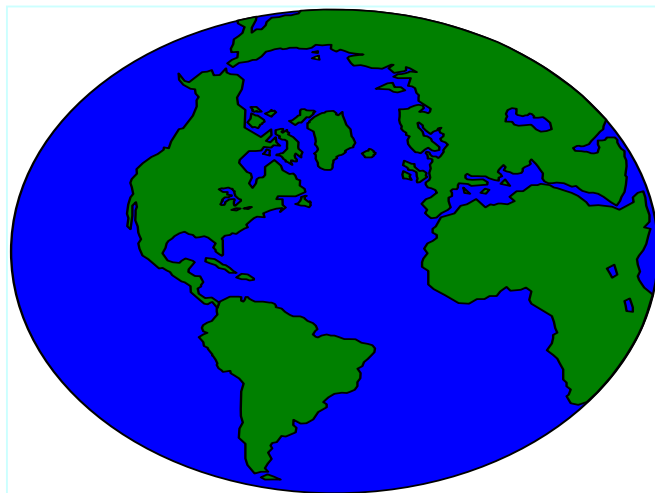

Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. As happened last year if we are over-subscribed enormously we will put on another festival on Monday 12th July. The fee is £4 per pupil. Formal events start at 11:00, schools can arrive from 10.15 . Please note: We have lost literally thousands of pounds over the last few years by schools who have booked pulling out. Schools who cancel after February 29th will be charged in full.
