HELP CHILDLINE BY RECYCLING YOUR OLD MOBILE PHONES

Imagine how many unwanted phones your staff and pupils will have after Christmas?

ChildLine is asking schools all over the UK to take part in our **Mobile Phone Amnesty** where unwanted mobiles are recycled to raise funds for ChildLine. You can choose any day or week from January to March for staff and pupils to hand in their old handsets and accessories. We are also asking interested schools to prepare in advance by letting their staff and pupils know before the Christmas break, so if they receive a new one as a gift they can save their old one for the Amnesty. It is an incredibly simple way of raising money for a good cause, with minimum effort! We also arrange collection of the phones to make it even easier!

Each mobile phone can raise as much as £70 for ChildLine and by taking part you will help ChildLine answer more calls from children and young people in your area.

Although children can call 0800 1111 for free, it costs ChildLine £3 to answer each call. Every day 4,000 children call ChildLine but due to lack of funds only 1,800 can get through to our counsellor's for the comfort, advice and protection; children like Sandie:

"I can't go back home. My stepfather beats me and calls me names... I sleep with the bed across my door... He drinks alot." Sandie, 15, had run away before and told the police about the physical violence, but "...there were no marks and the police didn't do anything. Mum and him didn't speak to me for a month." Sandie did eventually agree to contact social services and ChildLine was able to help her talk frankly to them and to say why she did not want to be returned home.

The Recycling Pack will provide you with everything you need to take part in the Amnesty including posters (endorsed by lan Wright) and ChildLine information etc. Your school will be sent a certificate of thanks on receipt of the phones and accessories.
