Remember Wurzel Gummage? Create your own scarecrow with recycled materials to be displayed at Spring Fling – the children's event on the Norfolk Showground on Tuesday 6th April

Scarecrows can be designed and made by a single child, a group of children or a class, years R -9. Only recycled materials must be used.

Each scarecrow must be free standing (perhaps in a flower pot filled with plaster) and not taller than 1.5m or wider than 1m.



Each scarecrow should be labelled with your school name, address and telephone number, and the names or class and year group of the children involved in the project.

The scarecrows should be delivered to Easton College before 4.30 pm on Friday 2nd April.
