Ruth Peel studied singing at the Royal Northern College of Music where she won both the Lieder and French Song prizes and several scholarships as well as the Kathleen Ferrier Decca Prize. She has performed worldwide in many operatic roles including *Kate* in Britten's Owen Wingrave, *Hippolyta* in Midsummer Night's Dream, and *Lucretia* in Rape of Lucretia at Snape Maltings. She has also sung in a number of major European Festivals.

Johannes Krebs started playing the cello at the age of seven. He has studied in Hanover, Dallas, Madrid and Cologne. He has won numerous prizes and awards in Germany, Austria, England and the USA. He is Principal Cellist of the Hamburg State Opera.

Marcus Barcham-Stevens graduated from the University of Cambridge with First Class Honours and later gained the Diploma of Advanced Solo Studies in violin from the Guildhall School.
