The Norwich Rivers Heritage Group is currently working on a project about the stretch of the River Wensum between Carrow and Whitlingham Country Park, the **RIVER GATEWAY TO NORWICH**.

In order to achieve our aim of making people aware of the assets and the potential of the area we are (with grant aid from the Countryside Agency's Local Heritage Initiative) producing a major exhibition which will be launched in early April. It will be housed in the Learning City Trailer and will tour to various sites in the City and also to some schools during the Summer Term. We are also producing a

Booklet called 'The Trowse Triangle' which will be distributed free to all schools when it is published in April.
