### **Young Disabled People and Sport Research Project**

Sports organisations in the east of England are embarking on a unique piece of research which will examine a number of aspects relating to the issues of young disabled people and sport. The research is being funded by the Active Sports Partnerships in conjunction with the English Federation of Disability Sport and will be carried out by Syzygy Leisure Ltd.
