The City of Norwich Aviation Museum at Horsham St Faith was built by volunteers and first opened to the public in 1985. Since those humble beginnings, the museum has steadily developed into a top local tourist attraction and educational facility. The collection features eleven aircraft parked outside, together with numerous indoor displays depicting Norfolk's aviation history.

Educational visits to the museum are becoming increasingly popular. Aircraft are exciting to children and seem to stimulate their interest. Subjects such as mathematics, science and history can be based on the exhibits at the museum, with facts, figures and questionnaires available to students and teachers.

Other facilities include parking, toilets, a gift shop and tea room, which can double as a classroom. The proximity of the site provides excellent viewing of activities at Norwich Airport.
