Course Context/Audience:

As part of the development of restorative cultures in schools mediation is a practical approach that children and young people can become involved in to support their peers. There are many conflicts and disagreements that arise in school communities that do not require the intervention of adults but for which children and young people need support if they are to be resolved. Peer mediation can provide this support. It is a process that helps to build peaceful school communities and helps the development of life skills for all the young people involved.

Each school will need to invest in materials to support their work in school following the training. They are: *The Peer Mediation and Mentoring Trainer's Manual by Belinda Hopkins* (£65) for all schools attending. Primary schools in addition may want to buy *Let's Mediate by Hilary Stacey and Pat Robinson* (£20.99) to support their work in classrooms.

Objectives:

The training the trainers course will skill staff to develop this approach in their own schools and will ensure that schemes that are set up are sustainable. It is anticipated that staff who attend this course will be willing to support the development of peer mediation in other schools and in this way build a bank of expertise in a wider range of schools.
