The Artsmark application deadline for Round 10 is 18th November 2009.

- Primary, secondary, special schools both maintained and independent
- Schools new to Artsmark and applying for the first time
- Schools reapplying for Round 10

- The assessment and the validation process explained
- Help to meet the deadline
- Major changes to Round 10 explained
- Specific school queries answered

Who is it designed for?

Artsmark Training Visits are designed for classroom teachers, arts coordinators and head teachers from primary, secondary, special and independent schools.
