# Labyrinth Challenge

A highlight of Festival Gardens (that's Chapelfield Gardens in Norwich for the rest of the year) will be an installation from Barcelona called *El Laberint* (7–22 May): a playful quest through a crazy network of transparent doors and windows in which visitors are given challenges and brain-teasers to help them navigate through the maze.

We're looking for quirky questions and clever conundrums for enigma doors within *El Laberint* and invite Norfolk schools to take part. We are offering special school workshops for Key Stages 2 and 3, led by Rebecca Chapman (Creative Practitioner). Up to thirty children can take part in each workshop. Participants will be taken through a fun, interactive and participative process and will create innovative and unique riddles and challenges. These will be entered into a competition. Winners will see their questions built into the labyrinth. There are opportunities for four schools to take part in these workshops on either **Tuesday 30 March** or **Thursday 1 April**, 9-11am and 1pm-3pm. Fee £25.
