Norfolk Dancers Bid To Perform On Theatre Stage

The search is under way for 100 young dancers to star in a major production at Norwich Theatre Royal. English Youth Ballet is returning to the venue by public demand to present Sleeping Beauty on July 2nd-3rd.

The company now needs to find young people aged 8 to 18 to star in the dramatic production and are preparing to put budding performers through their paces.

They will be holding auditions at the Open Academy on Marryat Road in Norwich on March 17th. They will run in two parts and will be open for 8-11 year olds from 4.30pm. Older children can then compete for a part with auditions for 12-18 year olds starting at 6.45pm.

Anyone who wants to take part is advised to register first by calling 01689 856747 or 01248 422337. They will then receive an Audition Pack which gives full details for students and parents.

John Bultitude, of Norwich Theatre Royal, said: "This is a great opportunity for the young people in this area to showcase their skills. They will also get the chance to appear onstage alongside some of this country's top professional dancers."

English Youth Ballet puts on full-scale ballet productions in seven UK locations every year. It has also won the Stage Award for Special Achievement In Regional Theatre, and the EYB's director Janet Lewis was awarded the OBE in the 2008 New Year's Honours for her work with dance.
