## **On the Trail of Norfolk's Stained Glass**

By popular demand, Hungate Medieval Art has organised a guided visit on one of the tours included on their Stained Glass Trails. The Trails together feature over 35 different churches and highlight some of Norfolk's most interesting stained glass.

On Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> July we invite you to join us on Trail 10, which covers the churches of Stratton Strawless, Cawston, and Salle. An extra bonus on this day out is the inclusion of Booton church.

There will be speakers in some or all of the churches, followed by time to look around at leisure. Included in the price of £28 is transport and a set sandwich lunch at the Ratcatchers pub in Eastgate. The coach will pick people up from Tombland at 10am and arrive back in Norwich between 4 and 4.30pm.

It may be unknown to many but medieval glass remains in over 200 of Norfolk's parish churches. By providing this unique day out Hungate Medieval Art aims to draw attention to some of these medieval treasures and allow people to explore a few of the beautiful churches where these windows are to be found.

## **Hungate Medieval Art**

Hungate Medieval Art is a registered charity (no. 1125694) which exists to promote the medieval art and artefacts visible in the County of Norfolk and in particular in the County's parish churches.

The Hungate Medieval Art interpretation centre is based in the redundant church of St Peter Hungate Church and is open to the public every Thursday, Friday and Saturday, 10.00-16.00. Admission is £3 for adults and £2.50 for concessions.

The centre currently features a permanent exhibition on Norfolk's medieval stained glass with beautiful back lit images of glass from across the county. Temporary exhibitions and a busy events programme look at other medieval art forms and what they meant to medieval people.
